

## CRAWLSPACE ENCAPSULATION AND WATERPROOFING, FLINT MI



Michigan Basements was contacted by the Genesee Intermediate School District regarding water intrusion and moisture issues in the crawl space under the school. A proposal was made to fully encapsulate the crawl space, and install a full perimeter interior drainage system with multiple sump pits that would discharge the water into the storm sewer.





The proposal was accepted and the project was completed during the month of August of 2018. Over 6,500 square feet of 90 mil encapsulation was installed on the walls, floors and columns in the crawlspace. Over 330 feet of SafeBasements drain tile was installed along with three SafeBasements sump basins with Pro Series PS-C33 combination pumps to control the water. Two Aprilaire 1850 dehumidifiers were installed as well. With all of the moisture issues taken care of the crawlspace will be safe for years to come, ensuring there are no other concerns rising to the rest of the floors above.



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
